

Doing Business with the Defense Logistics Agency TEN STEPS TO DOING BUSINESS WITH DLA

- 1. To do business with DLA, vendors need a DUNS number. To apply for or look up your company's number, go to www.dnd.com.
- 2. Vendors must register in the Central Contractor Registration and Establish a Record in ORCA.
- 3. Register on the DLA Internet Bid Board System (DIBBS): Go to: www.dibbs.bsm.dla.mil
- 4. Search the Federal Stock Classes Purchased by DLA: Visit www.dibbs.bsm.dla.mil under References, FCSs and Supplier Visibility Requirements Application.
